- Dressage will start at 11 am in the indoor arena. Once your entry is received you will be notified of your scheduled ride time. Dressage seat equitation will be the first class after lunch. No late entry (day of show) for dressage tests.
- Trail and Mini In hand Obstacle will be scheduled from 12-4 in the outdoor arena. If you are not showing in a rail class, you may enter your trail class, this includes mini in hand obstacle, and mini in hand jumping
- Tying to trailer is allowed during the day if area is cleaned up before departure (trailer must be hooked to truck or properly blocked up)
- Stalls must be swept out and clean of manure, hay and shavings before departing the fairgrounds there will be a \$15 fine due before the next show and no awards will be awarded

MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Volunteer Hours
 - a. Sign up to volunteer or pay \$20. Volunteer hours can be completed by any friend or family member
2. Order of go for both shows: Senior, Intermediate, Junior, Novice
3. 3-day flat fee \$85
 - a. Must enter showmanship plus 2 other classes per day (all 3 days)
4. \$8 per class
5. Stalls \$15
 - a. (all weekend plus shavings) for horses and tack during day and overnight.
 - b. Stalls must be swept out and clean of manure, hay and shavings before departing the fairgrounds there will be a \$15 fine due before the next show and no awards or no awards will be awarded
6. Camping
 - a. Full (water/Electric) \$26 daily
 - b. Electricity Only \$19 daily
 - c. Dry \$8 daily
7. Late Fee
 - a. \$10 Late fee
 - b. Show 1 Late fee applied if received after June 4, 2020
 - c. Show 2 Late fee applied if received after July 3, 2020

Check your level: As of Oct. 1, 2019

- Senior: 14 to less than 19 years of age
- Intermediate: 11 to 13 years of age
- Junior: 8 to 10 years of age
- Novice (Inter/Senior 1st year only)

3-Day high Point

(Senior, Intermediate, Junior) No Walk Trot or Novice

Pick 2 classes per day not including showmanship or non-qualifying classes identified by an asterisk. The top showmanship score will be used as a tie breaker if needed

Daily High Point

(Senior, Intermediate, Junior) No Walk Trot or Novice

All classes for that day excluding asterisks and showmanship. The top showmanship will be used if a tie breaker is needed.

Must have record book check list complete. For three-day high point turn in Friday can be turned in Thursday. Daily high point must turn in before morning of the show before showmanship is over. They will be accepted Thursday.

Dressage

(May only enter 2 dressage tests per show)

No late entries (day of show) for dressage tests.

Walk Trot exhibitors:

Can enter the following classes

Jumping/Dressage

Ground pole, Intro test A and B (English and Western)

Gaming

Gaming may enter any speed allowed, if you canter in gaming you no longer qualify for walk trot

Performance

English Eq, Western Eq, Trail

My Pre-Qualified Jumping Height

Section 1 -Ground pole Section 2 – 12”-18”
Section 3 - 18”-2’ Section 4 - 2’6-2’9

May only enter 2 jumping sections per show

Spokane County 4-H Jumping Qualification Checklist (Page 9 Supplemental Guide)

This form needs to have been completed at spring clinic/jump pre-qual, signed off and filed with the show manager. If you did not pre-qualify you MUST enter Section 1 or Section 2.

How to qualify for state?

Blue Danish in showmanship plus Blue Danish is that event.

Blue Danish in showmanship plus red Danish in that event, is a qualifier but will NOT take priority over blue Danish.

Intermediates: Performance and Dressage are combined.

Reining – will be included in the senior performance section

Dressage: Compete the highest test of your level.

Small equine is added for Intermediate and Senior

Must have an up to date record book. Must have participated in an educational event.
