

2020 WASHINGTON 4-H LIVESTOCK JUDGING CONTEST

Info:

1. In all judging contests, registration of all contestants will be completed prior to contest. Late registration will not be allowed.
2. All counties will be allowed up to two 10-member teams, one in the intermediate age division and one in the senior age division. It is the responsibility of County Extension personnel to identify eligible participants.
3. Any participant who does not complete all classes of the contest, including reasons classes, will be Disqualified.
4. County team scores will be determined by averaging the scores of all members completing the contest, provided there are at least three or more members from a county who complete the contest. If the county cannot enter a team of at least three members, one or two members from the county may judge as individuals.
5. County teams: Minimum of three individuals for a county team. If more than three individuals and up to 10 the top three individual scores will be average for a team score per county.
6. In the event of a tied score, the tie will be broken using the following criteria: a) the first tie breaker is the total oral reasons score; b) the second tie breaker is the score of the classes on which the oral reasons were given; c) the third tie breaker is the total written reasons score; d) the fourth tie breaker is the score of the classes on which the written reasons were given; e) if a tie remains after the fourth tie breaker, the last tie breaker is the flip of a coin.
7. State teams for national judging contests are not official until announced by the WA State 4-H Office.

Oral reasons

- Oral reasons are required for Intermediates and Seniors
- Introduce yourself, age division and county name.
- No notes
- No coaching
- Max 2 minutes
- Upload to YouTube using private setting

YouTube information that is important to share with exhibitors and families:

- Record the video and save, save as WA 4-H Youth Name, County Name
- Upload video using the create button,
- Provide them with a “title” format so you can track videos when you receive with entry,
- Instruct exhibitors and families to set their visibility setting to unlisted (so only people with the link will see)
- After uploading, choose to “Copy Video URL.” This is the link that you’ll use to enter.
