- ✓ Please also tell us what school you plan to attend and what you think your major will be.

*Applications are due by April 15th of each year.



II. Scholarship Support Eligibility (on a case by case basis for:

For example livestock, leadership or public speaking scholarship at a State events are eligible for up to \$200 and a National events are eligible for up to \$500.

- ✓ Current Spokane County 4-H members in good standing
- ✓ Enrolled in 4-H livestock projects for a minimum of one preceding year.
- ✓ Current on YQCA certification
- ✓ Complete record book from the preceding year involving a livestock project.
- ✓ For Event Scholarship please also tell us the type of event and what this experience means to you.
