MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. * These classes are not counted towards daily or 3 day HP
2. Classes in *Italics* are *NON STATE QUALIFIERS*. Everything else is.
3. Dressage starts at 1 pm- Indoor arena. First class is Dressage Seat EQ. Then the tests will follow. They may go on a different order than the schedule due to show management assigning ride times. There is no late entry (day of show) for dressage tests.
4. Trail-Green horse- Mini in hand is scheduled from 10-4 in the outdoor arena. If you are not showing in a rail ask you may enter your trail class. This includes mini in hand obstacles, green horse. Mini in hand jumping will wait until all those exhibitors are ready to show before they can go.
5. Tying to a trailer is allowed during the day if the area is cleaned up before departure. (Trailer must be hooked to the truck or properly blocked up)
6. Stalls must be swept out and clear of manure, hay and shavings before departing the fairgrounds, there will be a \$15 fine due before the next show and no awards will be awarded.
7. Volunteer Hours
 - a. Sign up to volunteer or pay \$20. Volunteer hours can be completed by any friend or family member
8. Order of go for both shows: Senior, Intermediate, Junior, Novice
9. Entry Fees
 - i. Are highly preferred that they are done online - we still will accept paper copies
 - b. Entries received earlier than or on the dates listed below, are entered in a raffle for \$25 off their show fee
 - i. Horse Show #1 May 30th, 2022
 - ii. Horse Show #3 June 27th, 2022
 - c. Late fees are applied after on and after the dates below and if entries are made the day of the show
 1. \$20 Late fee
 2. Show 1 Late fee applied if received after June 3, 2021
 3. Show 2 Late fee applied if received after July 1, 2021
 - d. 3-day flat fee \$85
 - i. Must enter showmanship plus 2 other classes per day (all 3 days)
 - ii. If you sign up for this, but do NOT show the proper number of classes you are responsible for the price difference
 - e. Single Class Entry
 - i. \$8 per class
10. Horse Stall \$25 per stall
 - a. (all weekend plus shavings) for horses during the day and overnight.
 - b. Stalls must be swept out and clean of manure, hay and shavings before departing the fairgrounds there will be a \$15 fine due before the next show and no awards or no awards will be awarded
11. Tack Stall \$15 per stall
 - a. must be clean of all shaving/hay/personal items
 - b. there will be a \$15 fine due before the next show and no awards or no awards will be awarded
12. Camping
 - a. Full (water/Electric) \$26 daily
 - b. Electricity Only \$19 daily
 - c. Dry \$8 daily

3-Day High Point

(Senior, Intermediate, Junior and Walk Trot) **NO Novice or green horse**

Pick 2 classes per day not including showmanship or non-qualifying classes identified by an asterisk. The top showmanship score will be used as a tiebreaker if needed

Daily High Point

(Senior, Intermediate, Junior and walk trot) **NO Novice or green horse**

All classes for that day excluding asterisks and showmanship. The top showmanship will be used if a tie breaker is needed.

Requirements

3 day and daily -Must have record book checklist complete.

For three-day high point turn in Friday can be turned in Thursday and online

Daily high point must turn in before morning of the show before showmanship is over. They will be accepted Thursday and online.

Check your level: As of Oct. 1, 2021

- o Senior: 14 to less than 19 years of age
- o Intermediate: 11 to 13 years of age
- o Junior: 8 to 10 years of age
- o Novice (Inter/Senior 1st year only)

Walk Trot exhibitors:

Can enter the following classes

Jumping/Dressage

Ground pole, Intro test A and B (English and Western)

Gaming

Gaming may enter any speed allowed, if you canter in gaming you no longer qualify for walk trot

Performance

English Eq, Western Eq, Trail

Dressage

(May only enter 2 dressage tests per show)

Example 1 english, 1 western; 2 english ;2 western

No late entries (day of show) for dressage tests.

Tests may be ridden out of order at discretion of show management- this will be reflected on the ride times assigned

Jumping

You must pre qualify at spring clinic to jump higher than section 3. If you do not pre qualify you must show at section 1 and 2.

If you pre qualified a previous year and could not qualify this year, please contact the show staff.

You may enter 2 sections at the show.

Example you may enter ground poles and one section of any height (if you pre qualified). This would be using ground poles as a warm up round
