- 2. Swipe** your EBT card for the amount you want to spend.
- 3. Match** your EBT dollars with SNAP Market Match. (Dollar for dollar match up to \$40/day)
- 4. Shop** for fresh produce and vegetable plant starts.

 **KERNEL** Free To-Go kid activities. Each come with \$2 voucher to purchase fresh produce or vegetable starts at farmers markets.
