



# Happy Trails safety rules and reminders



## CAMP RULES

- Boots must be worn around horses. Tennis shoes are appropriate for camp
- Shorts should be mid-thigh/ finger tip length
- Shirt sleeves required - short or long (no tank tops)
- Curfew/ Quiet Time is 9 PM
- All adults/visitors need a background check prior to camp
  - Non-camp registered siblings are welcome during visiting hours (6:30-8:30 pm)
- Adults **MUST** check in/out if leaving camp. Campers need expressed permission from the committee.
- Pets should stay at home
- No personal camp fires
- A fire extinguisher is required for anyone who cooks at their own camp
- Dispose of trash in proper areas (not portable restrooms)
- Generators use should be used as needed and not during quiet time.
- Kitchen and fridge are off limits without specific consent

## • HORSE RULES

- Panels should be tied shut with the halter rope.
- Feed and water your horse before you eat. First thing in the morning
- All riders (youth and adult) are expected to attend all classes
- Water is limited to horse drinking water only.
- Horses are to only be handled/ridden during riding classes.
- Campers must mount and dismount in arena and at designated trail class starting point. No horses through camp or nearby areas.
