D. Joni Kindwall-Moore, founder and CEO of Snacktivist Foods, is an Ethnobotanist, Registered Nurse and host of the Regenerative by Design Podcast. In her keynote address, Joni will share her experiences working with a broad cohort of researchers, producers, investors, and innovators who are at the core of the artisan grains movement across the U.S. and will challenge us to consider what it takes to develop a regenerative Inland Northwest artisan grains sector.



In Joni's own words "The grain industry is one of the oldest industries in the world. This industry has radically transformed over the past century, and the quest for yields in a global commodities market has transformed our farming landscapes and diets. These advancements have made strides in satisfying the calorie requirements of billions of people. This is something to be proud of."

"Yet, primarily focusing on yields has resulted in a system out of balance. We must renew our grain sector and add value diversity back into the equation. We must build an agricultural sector that is regenerative by design, which will require radical collaboration and innovative thinking across many sectors."

"This renewal has already begun. The Inland NW has the potential to be the global leader in grain industry regeneration. This transformation is from the soil up, and ripples through many facets of our local economy; from the field and family farm, to the miller and consumer."
