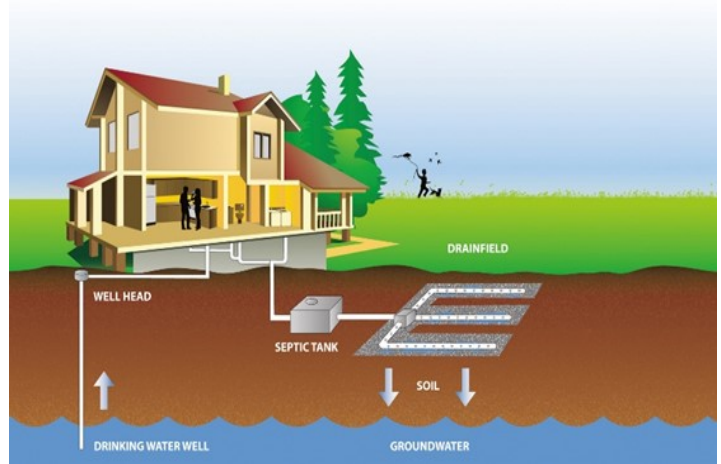
COST SHARE FOR SEPTIC SYSTEM REPAIR

Jefferson County Environmental Public Health is running a program to offer qualified applicants financial assistance with repair/replacement of their septic system.

Financial Help When You Need It

The Cost Share Program grants up to 100% of the cost of the repair or replacement of your onsite sewage system, up to \$20,000, if you meet the eligibility requirements below:

- Home is owner-occupied
- Property is near the shoreline or a stream that drains to the shoreline (some restrictions apply)
- A septic professional has evaluated the system as failing or failed. The septic system must be permitted or documented as pre-permit
- Income guidelines vary based on the number of people in your household. Please visit our website or call us to see if you qualify
