State Fair Report - Keely and Kody Crandall shared their experiences at the Washington State Fair. Discussion was held on how youth can help encourage the participation of other 4-H members.

Market Report – Abby reported that at the Fair Board meeting it was shared that some changes are being discussed for the future on requirements for posters. The Market Committee has called for a mandatory meeting on the 3rd of December for Livestock members. Checks were mailed out from the market auction.
