BITS & BUCKLES SCHOOLING SHOW CLASS RULES

Please check in at the registration table in Bloom Pavilion upon arrival.

COME AS YOU ARE: Formal riding attire not required. Riders should be neat, clean, and presentable. Boots with appropriate level heel must be worn. Shaggy but clean horses encouraged. HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL NOVICE, JUNIOR, INTERMEDIATE, AND SENIOR EXHIBITORS IN ALL MOUNTED CLASSES. NOVICES ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR HELMETS IN SHOWMANSHIP. We also recommend helmets be worn while working with the horses.

AGE DIVISIONS: Age divisions are based on age as of October 1, 2023.

Members must have reached their 8th birthday by October 1st of the current 4-H year Senior and Novice Senior: 14 to less than 19 years of age Intermediate and Novice Intermediate: 11 to 13 years of age Junior and Novice Junior: 8 to 10 years of age Novice = first year showing in horse 4-H.

In compliance with a directive from the attorney general at Washington State University, entries for children under the age of eight (8) or less than third grade in school are not allowed. Please be sure that those handling or riding any horse on the Kittitas County Fairgrounds are at least eight years of age. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation. Thank you.

SHOWMANSHIP: Showman to demonstrate ability to lead, turn, and move their animal as directed by the Judge. Showman should be familiar with the Quarter System.

EQUITATION: Riders will be judged on seat, posture, head, legs, hands, balance, distribution of weight, and aids. They will also be judged on performance of horse. Horses should be able to perform at a walk, trot/jog, canter/lope; be able to take correct lead, back readily and perform any tests the judge may ask of them.

PLEASURE: Horse to be judged on manners and performance. Should be able to perform skills listed for Equitation Class.

DISCIPLINE RAIL: This is an advanced pleasure class which tests the skills of both horse and rider, as they execute specific gaits, transitions and movements as requested by the judge. In this class, competitors are asked to do things other than just go around the rail- you may be asked to side pass, hand gallop, pivot, back up, roll back, lead change, extend trot, counter canter (lope) etc.- The class is judged on performance and manners. Competitors in this class can be dressed in either English or Western attire.

GREEN HORSE: A green horse will be identified as a horse under 6 years old that has not been shown in a shank bit. An aged green horse will be identified as a horse 6 years old or older that has not been shown in a shank bit. To be shown at a walk - jog/trot - lope/canter both ways of the ring.

RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY: Owners and riders/handlers are responsible for their horses at all times. Please make this a safe show. Use **Red Ribbons** for tails of horses that kick. Please clean up after yourself and your horse.

No horses on the grass, horses cannot be tied to trailers on the grass. Horses may be tied to trailers in the parking lot. Stalls are available for \$5. Overnight stalls are \$10. Please bring your shovels and rakes to clean out stall(s) at the end of the day or at the end of the show.

If you are parking in front of the barns on the grass, please DO NOT drive over the sidewalk!

No stallions please.

WARM-UP ARENA: To be supervised by a leader or parent. Please walk your horse through the parking lot—not on the street to the warm-up arena. Important class information:
