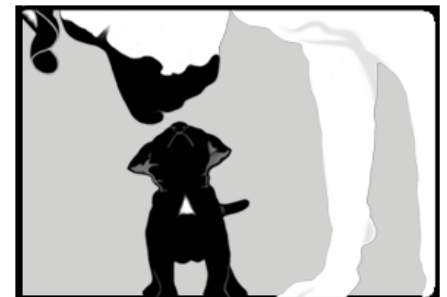


Pet Appreciation Week at Del's

FREE 4-H Livestock Record App

The new **4-H Livestock Record app** is now **available for download (free)** on the iTunes AppStore.

Do you agonize over 4-H record keeping? 4-H youth (and club leaders) with livestock projects will now be able to organize their market livestock project information on their iPhone or iPad and send customized reports right to their email inbox. These reports provide information needed to complete record books.

Here's what you can do with it:

- Track your 4-H'ers and their individual livestock project animals
- Track participation in events, meetings, shows, contests and more
- Record animal weights, feed, and health and monitor average daily gains
- Enter project income, expenses, and assets to generate financial statements
- Use photos to customize each 4-H'er and animal
- Export reports to analyze in spreadsheets, create graphs, or use in your state or local 4-H record keeping forms



The app requires iOS 7.0 or later. It's compatible with iPhone, iPad, and iPod touch and is optimized for iPhone 5.

Get Ready to Have a BLAST — Rockets to the Rescue

When disasters strike, logistics can be a key challenge for emergency responders trying to deliver food aid and supplies to the people who need it most. Severe storms can flood roads, take out bridges, ports and runways, and make even normal transportation options practically impossible. As an aspiring aerospace engineer, your challenge is to come up with an aerospace design idea for solving this problem.



A **4-H National Youth Science Day Experiment** is being scheduled **in our area this October**. Watch the Friday Update for the time and place for the event launching where you will design, build, and test a propulsion system and prototype Food Transportation Device (FTD) that can accurately deliver its food payload to a specific target.
