


# 2002 Columbia Basin Shallot Evaluation\*

## Yield (Tons per acre)

Ambition	30.2	0.8
Matador	28.7	0.3
Mirage	27.4	0.7
Prisma	27.2	0.3

\*Shallots seeded in two double rows on 34" beds on seeded March 28 under center pivot irrigation and harvested on August 6. All tops were down at harvest but Prisma and Matador were still partially green with some life remaining. Ambition was most mature.
