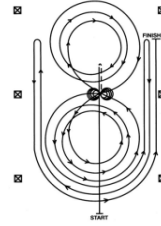

### Fair Changes

### Fair Grounds

- 1 All sick/injured horses MUST be reported to the superintendent immediately.
- 2 Horse who can not be on shavings. This Solutions should remove need for straw  
The fair grounds are/will work on leveling out the stalls for Rubber Mats.  
Rubber Mats may be used, but they will need to be furnished. They will not be supplied.
- 3 We are still planning on meeting in the spring to check for other items. (safety)
- 3 The fastest time board and clock will be moved prior to fair.
- 4 Pee Wee kids (or those too young to be enrolled in 4H) may only participate in the following-  
Will be able to compete in their own groom squad class.

- The Rider MUST HAVE A **HELMET and boots**
