HORSE/RIDER PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE

I certify that _____ has passed the Rider Proficiency Test. Rider has demonstrated the proper skills to compete in the Grant/Adams County 4-H Horse Jumping Program. Rider has also completed a tack inspection and has proven that his/her tack is safe for use in the above referenced program.

Juniors will be allowed to ride ground poles. If they can demonstrate proficient skills they will be allowed to jump fences up to 12 inches.

Intermediates will be allowed to ride ground poles. If they demonstrate proficient skills they will be allowed to move up to 12 inches then to 18 or 24 inches.

Seniors will be allowed to ride ground poles. If they demonstrate proficient skills, they will be allowed to move up 12 inches then to 18 inches or 24 inches. A maximum height of 36 inches will be allowed for qualified seniors.

We agree to hold Tester, Grant/Adams 4-H, and Washington State University harmless in the event horse or rider is injured while participating in the 4-H Jumping Program.
