OUR 2019 POSTER CONTEST IS ACCEPTING SUBMISSIONS

AWARD FOR THE WINNING DESIGN:

- Prizes will be awarded to First, Second, and Third Place winners: \$250 for First Place, \$100 for Second Place, and \$50 for Third Place.
- Winning design displayed throughout the Columbia Basin and at the annual Eco-Gardening Symposium in April 2019.

DESIGN GUIDELINES:

1. Color art is to be the original work of the entrant.
2. The purpose of the contest is to design a poster promoting the annual Eco-Gardening Symposium as it applies to urban and rural gardening. The 2019 focus is on gardening solutions that apply to weed control, watering, cover crops, and soil management.
3. The artwork should be in finished form and unframed.
4. Poster size is: 11"x17". Design must be smaller than 11"x17".
5. The design and design rights become the property of Grant County Conservation District and Grant-Adams Master Gardener Foundation Committee who administer the Eco-Gardening Symposium and will be adapted for posters, advertisements, T-shirts, pins, programs and/or print and media, and for promotional or business purposes in the future.
6. Deadline for submission is December 17, 2018. Submissions may be sent to Marie-Lotz@conserveva.net or dropped off at Grant County Conservation District, 1107 S Juniper Drive, Moses Lake, WA 98837. When submitting, include your name, address, email and phone number.

PURPOSE

AWARD FOR THE WINNING DESIGN

DESIGN GUIDELINES:

1. The logo must be original work of the submitter.
2. The purpose of the contest is to design a logo promoting the Eco-Gardening Symposium but not limited to gardening, trees, soil, water, native plants/landscaping, and cover crops.
3. The logo should be in finished form.
4. Entries must be submitted as JPEG files. The logo must be easy to use, handle, resize, and manipulate for all reproduction purposes. It should be visually appealing on both small and large scale.
5. The design and design rights become the property of Grant County Conservation District and Grant-Adams Master Gardener Foundation Committee who administer the Eco-Gardening Symposium and will be adapted for website, printed matter, posters, advertisements, T-shirts, pins, programs and/or print and media, and for promotional or business purposes in the future.
6. Deadline for submission is December 17, 2018. Submissions may be sent to Marie-Lotz@conserveva.net or dropped off at Grant County Conservation District, 1107 S Juniper Drive, Moses Lake, WA 98837. When submitting, include your name, address, email and phone number.

Entries will be selected at the sole discretion of the Eco-Gardening Committee. The winner will be notified by phone or email and honored at the 2019 symposium workshop in April.
