

Grant County Horse Committee June 13th, 2019

Location: Huck Fuller Bldg./ Meeting called to order at 7:06

Pledges/ Sign-in:

Previous meeting minutes:

- They were read by Tayler Hunt. Scott Howe made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Dennie Goyne seconded the motion. And the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report:

- Total amount in the account is \$5,796.35
 - The break down is:
 - Western Games still only has \$200
 - The general accounts total is \$4,121.35
 - The schooling show funds are \$1,475
- There was a deposit of \$356.13 on May 7th,2019
 - \$275 of that went to the schooling show funds.
 - And \$81.13 went to the award funds.
- There was another deposit of \$950 on June 10th,2019.
 - \$700 of that went toward the schooling show funds.
 - And the remainder of \$250 went toward the schooling show funds. (This was a sponsorship from the Ghost Gamers 4-H club)
- There is another deposit of \$302.55 that will be on July's treasurer's report.
 - \$150 of that was Basin Boots and Bits sponsorship for awards.
- Scott Howe motioned to approve the treasurer's report as read. Denny Goyne seconded the motion. And the motion passed.

Old Business:

- **Schooling shows:**
 - Don't forget which dates your club has signed up for.
 - Everybody needs to make sure they are signed up to help at one schooling show and ride at one schooling show.
- Needing to find the herdsman ship check Jenny Gunderson turned in to horse council.
- Needing to get sponsorship money from the clubs. (they were due June 1st,2019)
 - Ribbons for fair have already been ordered we are using the club's sponsorship money for the different awards.
- Denny Goyne made a motion to extend the sponsorship date to July 15th,2019. Sue brown seconded the motion. And the motioned passed.

New Business:

- Fair entries are open, make sure you sign up for your classes.
 - If you are wanting to do horse judging you have to make sure you are signed up by the July 1st, 2019. You will still be able to participate in the class, but you will not get the premium points.
- Sue Dillman made a motion to have horse council pay for the fair judge's campsite. Rae Ann seconded the motion. And the motion passed.
 - The campsite is \$80.
- Secretary books for the clubs should be turned in by June 15th, 2019.
- **State fair requirements:** Dawn is going to table this till a later date.
- Barn 47 and 46 will not be used at fair.
 - They are unsafe for 4-Her's to use
 - There are boards missing
 - Braces are broken
 - Some stall doors don't open all the way
 - There are big holes in the stalls
- Need to add to the sponsorship board.
 - There is at least 8 if not more, new sponsor's that need to be added.
