Pledges/ Sign-in:

Previous meeting minutes:

- They were read by Tayler Hunt. Scott Howe made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Maria Howe seconded the motion. And the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report:

- Sue Dillman was not at the meeting.
- Still don't have the treasury books until the state audit is complete. The audit should hopefully be done by the 15th of July.
- Maria Howe made a motion that there was no new treasurer's report at the time.

Old Business:

- **Fair entries**
 - Make sure your signed up for all your classes.
 - The deadline is August 1st.
- **Fair requirements**
 - Safety checks need to be done by June 1st.
 - Community service, Functions & Fundraisers deadline is July 31st.
 - Every 4-H kid needs to ride & help at one of the schooling shows.
 - Each club needs to donate \$150 or sponsor awards for an event.
- **State Fair requirements**
 - Record book needs to be turned in
 - Can do horse judging
 - Can do an interview
 - If you have a blue in showmanship you can show in any event that you have a red or higher in. If you have a red in showmanship you can only show in events that you get a blue-ribbon in.

New Business:

- White trail riders received 2 donation checks for horse council.
 - One is from clear risk solutions for \$100
 - One is from Quanis club of Ephrata for \$100
- We have a recipe for our showmanship round robin buckles that Jenny Gunderson ordered.
 - Becky Shae made a motion to pay Jenny Gunderson back the \$281.96 for the buckles when our account becomes available. Scott Howe seconded the motion. And the motion passed.
- Scott Howe motioned that every club needs to bring at least 2 cases of water for fair. Becky Shae seconded the motion. And the motion passed.
- First Schooling show went well.
 - There are a few things we need to work on with the kids.
 - ❖ Some kids are still having some issues being able to saddle and bridle their own horses. As leaders if our kids are checked off on the safety checks as being able to do so we need to make sure they are learning the proper way to safely handle their horses.
 - ❖ If the kids need help with their horse, they need to ask another 4-H member or go talk to the committee to see if an adult can assist them.
- Fair awards
 - As of right now we only have ribbons, buckles and hoof picks for awards.
 - Scott Howe made a motion to use only the ribbons, buckles and hoof picks as awards for 2019 fair, unless the account becomes available in a timely fashion to order different awards. Tayler Hunt seconded the motion. And the motion passed.
 - Becky Shae mad a motion to cap the money spent on awards at \$2400. Tayler Hunt seconded the motion. And the motion passed.
