

## LEW EVANS MEMORIAL TROPHY

In 1949, an award was established in memory of Lew Evans, former Yakima County Sheriff. Mr. Evans was a staunch supporter of 4-H, as well as a 4-H leader. The trophy, established as an inspiration for 4-H clubs to render a service to their fellow man locally or worldwide, is awarded annually to a club performing outstanding community service.

In selecting the 4-H club to receive the award consideration is given to the:

1. type of community service activities.
2. percent of member participation.
3. extent of harmony and good will that was developed.
4. effect the activity had on the club and others involved.

The service activity may have been of benefit to individuals or groups outside of 4-H or to other 4-H members. The club selected to receive the Lew Evans Memorial Trophy has every right to be proud that the Trophy belongs to them for a year.
