- **This is a Yakima County state-fair qualifying show for 4-H performance and gaming events.**
- This show will be operated in accordance with the rules for the 4-H Performance Horse project (*The PNW 4-H Horse Contest Guide*: <https://catalog.extension.oregonstate.edu/pnw574>). In accordance with 4-H rules, all riders must be at least 8 years of age as of October 1, 2018. All youth riders must wear an approved helmet, when mounted. No stallions of any age allowed. All 4-H classes will be judged according to the Danish System.
- **Out of County:** Out of county participants are welcome. 4-Hers wishing to ride for medals must preregister. Preregistration must include a copy of the medal pattern to be ridden and the score sheet.
- **Class Entries:** Preentries must be postmarked at least one week prior to show. Medal classes must be preentered. No exceptions. Post entries to classes #1 through #3 must be made by 8:45 a.m. All other post entries must be made three classes before the class being entered. No refunds.
- **Youth Walk-Trot Closed:** Riders must be no more than 18 years of age as of October 1, 2018. Riders must be beginning riders, who have never competed in the show ring at the lope/canter. No cross entry into any canter or loping class, except that riders may enter gaming classes (49-68), according to their 4-H or open division. No green horses.
- **Showmanship:** All 4-H participants must compete in Showmanship, with each horse entered in a 4-H class. Showmanship patterns will be performed one contestant at a time in the arena, to allow for multiple horses in a 4-H class. No penalty will be assessed for sweat marks due to morning classes.
- **English Classes:** English classes may be ridden in the rider's choice of hunt seat or saddle seat.
- **Disciplined Rail:** Also referred to as "command" or "judge's choice". This is an equitation class in which riders perform maneuvers as a group, testing the skills of both the horse and rider, as they execute specific gaits, transitions, and/or movements as requested by the judge. Rider's choice of seat. All humane bits allowed. Rider's may ride two-handed.
- **Working Pairs:** This will be a rail class. Riders should always mirror each other. This class is judged on horsemanship skills which include correct leads, balanced gaits, transitions and overall uniformity. Riders' choice of seat. 4-H riders may pair across age divisions, however, riders will be judged against the higher age division. Each rider may enter only one 4-H class.
- **Trail Class:** Trail class will open at the conclusion of Showmanship and run concurrent with gaming classes. Rider's choice of seat.
- **4-H Medal Classes:** Any Yakima County 4-H exhibitor who has earned 3 blue flats during the current age classification (Jr, Int, Sr) is qualified to ride for Medals in that event (individual pattern). Please specify which Medal you seek on the entry (Bronze, Silver, Gold #1, Gold #2, or Platinum). All 4-H medal classes MUST be preentered. Medal patterns are posted on the Yakima County 4-H website.
- **Lunch Break:** There will be a ½ hour break, after Bareback classes. Concessions will be available.
- **NOTE:** Anyone who wishes to bring their horse and ride, but not enter as a contestant, must sign the attached release form and pay a \$10.00 fee for facilities usage/insurance. This does not cover entry into any classes.
