Virtual Companion Animal Challenge

The Virtual Companion Animal Challenge offers a variety of 4-H companion animal contests that don't require live animals, including an essay, art, and photography contests. Youth have the opportunity to display their companion animal knowledge through these contests.



Age Divisions

- Junior: 8 10 years of age as of October 1 of the current 4-H year
- Intermediate: 11-13 years of age as of October 1 of the current 4-H year
- Senior: 14-18 years of age as of October 1 of the current 4-H year

Themes

- Careers with companion animals
- Animal health and/or nutrition
- Good husbandry/grooming
- Training and showing
- Human-animal bond
- Companion animal service or citizenship

Rules

- 1. Entrants do not need to be enrolled in the companion animal projects. However, participants must be enrolled 4-H members.
- 2. Participants may participate in all contests held as part of the 4-H Companion Animal Challenge.
- 3. Individuals may enter up to three exhibits. Exhibits cannot be the same photo at different angles.
- 4. Photographs may be taken with a film, digital cameras, or smartphone.
- 5. Photos must be shot by the 4-H member during the current 4-H year.
- 6. Exhibits must be submitted digitally.
- 7. As youth are able to submit more than 1 entry, they are eligible to win multiple placings depending on judge scoring.
- 8. Submit a small 2-3 sentence story of your photograph.
