- ★ The "Modeling Information Sheet" form is for the Fashion Revue commentator. Please have it completed and ready to turn in on the day of judging.
- ★ Your pattern (commercial or self-created) needs to accompany you on April 9 for judging.
- ★ If you do not have someone to commentate for members as they model, bring the typed script(s) on Wednesday when members are judged. There are a few older members who are willing to read scripts. Arrive at the *Fruitvale Grange* at **6:00 pm** on **Friday**, **April 12th** to practice with the commentator.

Creative Consumer Fashion Contest

All 4-H'ers are encouraged to enter the "Creative Consumer Fashion Contest", a coordinated outfit contest which showcases a selected occasion. The items don't have to be sewn by the 4-H members. Here is a chance to show off consumer and fashion sense. A commentary will be needed for modeling on Friday. These entries will be judged on Wednesday night with the rest of the clothing judging.

A member, leader or parent should be the commentator. Practice modeling with scripts, which members write <u>before</u> they come to the show. During judging, garments are expected to be accessorized with items carried (i.e. teddy bears, a ball, etc.) just as the members will present themselves at the program.
