



Follow the directions and you will be in compliance. It is free but does require you to enter your social security number. Thank you in advance for taking ten minutes to stay in compliance.

GIVEPULSE, WSU'S NEW VOLUNTEER HOURS PLATFORM

WSU is now utilizing GivePulse for 4-H volunteers to document the hours they spend working on behalf of Washington State 4-H Youth Development. GivePulse replaces the volunteer hours database previously used. Volunteers must be approved in 4HOnline before they can utilize this program to record volunteer hours.

Some of you may have already received a welcome email asking you to "Claim Your Account". If you haven't, don't worry! Sue will be sending an email next week with instructions on how to sign up and get started using GivePulse. Please consider if you will want to track your hours from a desktop computer or from the GivePulse app on your phone.

Remember that recording your hours is the only way for volunteers to be covered under WSU's L&I insurance policy. We are here to support you and look forward to helping you navigate the new system.



PACIFIC COUNTY 4-H PUBLIC SPEAKING CONTEST THIS SUMMER!

This summer 4-H public speaking will be back in full force! On a sunny summer Saturday (date to be determined) clubs will have the opportunity to sign up their members to give a presentation at the county level. Here they will be judged. When a member receives a blue at county they have the opportunity to do the same talk at fair and receive their blue ribbon and premium



points without being judged again. If they received a red or white they have the opportunity to be judged again and earn a blue. Remember presentations start at the club level so have your members give their presentation to the membership. It makes fair and county so much easier.

A **DEMONSTRATION** puts words into action. An effective demonstration teaches others how to do something by showing while telling. At the end of a demonstration, you should have a finished product to show your audience.

Sample titles include: how to cook an egg, how to groom a dog, how to braid hair, how to make a sandwich,

An **ILLUSTRATED TALK** makes use of posters, pictures, <u>PowerPoint</u> (for Junior, Intermediate, and Senior 4-Hers), or other visuals to show how to do something or illustrate a process. No finished product is required.

Sample titles include: how to plan a garden, how to distinguish horse markings, how to lead a fun and effective club meeting

PUBLIC SPEAKING is a prepared speech on a specific subject for an audience. Usually, no props or visual aids are used. 4-H members use this type of presentation to teach, entertain, and/or inform their audiences.

Sample titles include: why I like the 4-H cat project, 4-H around the world, what compassion looks like in my community

Are you thinking "but it has been so long since we did this." Need a refresher? Contact your Extension Staff and arrange for Toni to come to your club meeting and give you a hand.

RECOMMENDED TIME LIMITS FOR 4-H PRESENTATIONS

For demonstrations and illustrated talks the minimum time is 3 minutes and the maximum is 20 minutes, depending on 4-H "age" (your age on Oct. 1 of the current 4-H year). For public speeches the minimum time is 5 minutes and a maximum time is 10 minutes

4-H Age Division	Age	Time limits
Cloverbuds	5-7 years old	Less than 5 minutes
Juniors	8-10 years old	3-8 minutes
Intermediates	11-13 years old	5-15 minutes
Seniors	14-<19 years old	10-20 minutes
