CONFORMATION DESCRIPTION

Excellent 15, 14, 13—no more than minor faults in any of the major items of conformation. Basically correct in structure, outstanding in muscular development, has optimum outside fat.

12, 11, 10-no more than moderate faults in muscular and skeletal structure. Muscular de-

Good 12, 11, 10—no more than moderate faults in muscular and skeletal structure. Muscular development is not outstanding, but is average to good. Skeletal structure is basically sound.

Fair 9, 8, 7-has moderate to severe faults in some items of skeletal and muscular structure.

Muscular development is usually average to inferior.

Poor 6, 5, 4—may have serious structural defects and may be definitely lacking in muscling.

Extremely Inferior 3, 2, 1-extremely lightly muscled animals.
