**Old Business:**

Patti enjoyed her 1<sup>st</sup> 4-H Conference a lot. Michelle thought this year's conference was better than last years.

**New Business:**

Super Saturday - We have 6 classes set up for this Saturday from 9-12 here at the Chelan Co. Extension Office. There are a few signed up already and hopefully there will be more. Classes include Just for Teens, Parliamentary Procedures, Sewing, New Leader Training, State Fair Entries and On-Line Record Books. There will also be a craft table. Michelle is planning another day later in the year.

Insurance – Michelle presented a new insurance through the State 4-H Office. We discussed as a group our current insurance. The fees from our current insurance were discussed. Julia moved that we reduce our individual insurance fees to \$3 per person. Bill 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion failed.

Demonstration Concerns – There are concerns that we are seeing a decline of presentation of demonstrations at the County level. Polly will check with other counties to see what they offer for county demonstration incentives.

NCW Fair – Ellis read a letter from the WA State Fair Assoc. discussing the proposed state budget cuts including those for Fairs. They are asking for a Fair representative to attend in support of our Fair. Ellis suggested that we need a representative and that he would like to see Bob Brown attend and have the Leaders Council contribute toward his expenses. Ellis moved to pay Bob's expenses to attend the Legislative Session in Olympia in January. Patti 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion passed.

Elections – Patti moved we postpone elections until the next meeting. Ellis 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. The motion passed.
