

**Chelan County Leaders' Council Minutes
July 12, 2010**

Attendance: Cindy Aston, Thera Judd, Donna Mazur, Linda Simons, and Shelly Stamps.

The July 12, 2010 meeting of the Chelan County Leaders' Council was called to order at 7:05 by President Thera.

Minutes: Linda made a motion to approve the June 2010 minutes. The motion was seconded and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Cindy reported that there is \$3,679.68 in checking and \$2,287.79 in the CD. Cindy asked for approval to pay the following bills: \$4.00 for insurance for Saddlerock n Riders petting zoo, \$130.63 for year end awards, and \$1.01 for pins. Linda made a motion to pay the bills. The motion was seconded and approved.

Linda made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. The report was seconded and approved.

Old Business:

Thera indicated deadline for stall reservations for Waterville Fair and Chelan County fair is July 31st.

Spirit of Clover deadline is also July 31st.

If you have recommendations for judges for demonstration day send information to Thera.

Committee Reports:

Horse - There will not be an open show at Chelan County Fair. Grant County may be invited to show at the Chelan County Fair. There will be 2 qualified riders at the senior level and 2 qualified riders at the intermediate level for the Washington State Fair.

Record Book - Record books are due October 4, 2010.

Demonstrations - Demonstrations will be held August 5th and 10th at the Chelan County Fairgrounds.

Scholarships - No applications were received.

Fair - Discussion took place regarding 4H selling ice at the Chelan County Fair. The last time 4H was responsible for selling ice they made an approximate \$500.00 profit. Cindy indicated it is a lot of work. She will not be able to help with the selling of ice, therefore, someone needs to take over the responsibility for organizing it. Mary Ellen will be asked to put out an e-mail asking for a volunteer. Cindy will type up the requirements for selling the ice.

New Business:

Shelly presented the idea that more than one child should be recognized for their success on demonstration day. A lot of hard work is put into these demonstrations and other awards are presented to the top 3 participants in other events. Shelly made a motion to recognize 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place demonstration participants in each age category. The motion was seconded and approved.

Cindy wanted to know if ribbons were being distributed at demonstration day. The Tschetter family had donated money for the distribution of ribbons on demonstration day. Need to check with Mary Ellen to see how many ribbons are left.

Donna indicated that the Ponderosa 4-H Club would like to provide a “Fun Day” to promote social interaction and friendship amongst the 4-H kids.

Discussion was held regarding a horse day camp at Appleatchee for 2011. Ideas included providing evening activities such as educational presentations. Campers would possibly be required to bring their own food.

Donna is going to follow up on the pursuit of the round robin rule.

The new hire for the WSU extension office is set for August 20th.

The next meeting was set for October 4, 2010.
