**4-H MEMBER PERMISSION TO STAY OVERNIGHT AT FAIRGROUNDS  
DURING NCW FAIR**

4-H club members who exhibit animals (including horses, beef, sheep, swine and goats) during the NCW Fair are responsible for the care and feeding of these animals as well as the cleaning of stalls in which those animals are housed. This makes it necessary for at least a portion of these livestock project members to remain at the fairgrounds overnight.

Any 4-H member remaining at the fairgrounds overnight must be responsible to his/her parent or an adult leader who is also remaining overnight. In addition, they are responsible to that adult for their share of work in maintaining a clean and well-cared-for exhibit. All members staying overnight will report to the adult in charge of their building prior to 6:30 p.m. in the evening of each night that they plan to stay. Parents are responsible for seeing that this is done. All members with livestock will report to the adult in charge of their section upon arrival to determine their share of responsibility for maintaining the exhibit.

4-H club members who have paid for 4-H insurance are covered for the time they are on the fairgrounds and participating in 4-H activities.

**PERMISSION TO REMAIN OVERNIGHT AT THE FAIRGROUNDS**
