ServSafe is a nationally recognized comprehensive food safety training and certification program for anyone involved in food preparation or the food service industry. The training includes the latest updates in food safety and best practices used in the industry to implement critical food safety procedures. It is the highest standard in food safety training and certification to help managers keep food safe and protect the public from foodborne illness. In addition to learning about preventive measures to keep food safe, the course also includes crisis management and handling emergency situations. ServSafe is an opportunity to obtain nationally accredited food safety certification from the National Restaurant Association.

The cost for this course is \$130 and includes the textbook and test. Each participant needs his/her own textbook. Pre-study is highly recommended. Upon receipt of registration money, a textbook will be mailed to you. Successful completion of the course includes a ServSafe certificate for 5 years.

Please fill out the registration form and mail it to WSU Extension with your payment. Registration should be received by November 22 to assure a textbook and ample study time. Class size is limited to 25 people.
