Stephanie talked first about things happening around the state.

- Groups are doing virtual shows that include taking photos and submitting them by email, facebook, etc.
- There are fee-based programs available
- Videos need to be simple
- Looking at how a state 4-H virtual show would look
- Virtual showcase tool kit

Both fairs are holding livestock sales

Need to keep with the Danish System if judging entries in a virtual showcase

Remember that not everyone has the same ability with technology

Equine Western Games have been difficult to do virtually

Katrina mentioned that Chelan Co. Leaders' Council had only looked at a still life virtual showcase, but that leaves the non-market animals with nothing for a showcase.

Discussed whether we should do a showcase on a private site, or should it be open for the public to view.

How do we get things to potential judges that don't do "facebook". Could things be posted in class blocks?

The committee agreed on these recommendations:

- Do it as Bi-County
- Limit of 2 entries/project enrolled in
- Special Showcase ribbon
- Send out judges' comments

- In by September 1, 2020
- If there is a State Showcase, Michelle will select quality items that would have earned a blue or red award if the items had been judged
- Use local people for making comments on entries. Bonnie Grant will contact people.

Discussed the possibility of a Knowledge Bowl contest. There are practice tests available on line.

Judging – There is judging available at livestockjudging.com

Ribbons will be “designed” by a committee: Katrina, Debbie Fisch, Polly and Celia.

Michelle and Stephanie will work on developing an entry form, also ideas for how-to best present entries.

Katrina volunteered to make a flyer to advertise the showcase. The aim is to have an initial plan by next Friday (July 24, 2020).
