MEETS COURT REQUIREMENTS

By order of Chelan County Superior Court and Douglas County Superior Court Local Rule 94.04 H, class attendance is mandatory for all parents with children under 18 years old involved in dissolution, declaration or invalidity, custody, visitation, paternity and post-judgment proceedings. Upon completion of the class, participants will receive a certificate to file with the court prior to their court hearing.

WHAT IS “SUPPORTING CHILDREN THROUGH DIVORCE”?

“Supporting Children Through Divorce” is a 4-hour educational program designed to help parents focus on the needs of their children during and after divorce and separation.

Topics Include:

- How children react to divorce
- What children need to do to adjust
- How parents can help
- Resolve conflict without involving children
- Co-parenting
- New family structures
- When children are at risk
- How to get help

This class is open to anyone interested, including people already divorced or thinking about separation, extended family members and friends. This class is not meant to serve as counseling, therapy or ministry. Many parents who have taken the class recommend attending the class as early as possible in the separation or divorce process.

WHEN WILL CLASSES BE HELD?

This four-hour class is offered in one 4-hour session on Saturdays and in two 2-hour sessions on Tuesday and Thursdays. Those attending the Tuesday and Thursday evening classes must attend both sessions to complete the course.
