

2019 OUTSIDE 4-H ACTIVITY RELEASE FORM

Cowlitz County 4-H Horse Project

All 4-H exhibitors involved with the Thunder Mountain Rodeo or any other event outside of the 4-H Horse Program must declare their involvement with the 4-H Show Manager no later than one week prior to the July Cowlitz County Fair, which is Wednesday July 17th.

WSU Extension and the Cowlitz County 4-H Program, including the Cowlitz County 4-H Horse project will not be held responsible for, nor provide any oversight of the 4-H member or their horse once they leave the 4-H Horse barn. This for any event outside of the 4-H Horse program.

Only the 4-H Cowlitz County horse exhibitors may remove or return their horse to the 4-H horse barn.

In other words, once the 4-H horse and 4-H member leaves the 4-H Horse Barn, they are doing so at their own risk with no protection from WSU or Cowlitz County.

4-H Horse Exhibitors who miss a class due to participation in this non 4-H activity, will be allowed to participate in that missed class as long as that specific event is still being offered in *their age division*.

4-H Horse Exhibitors wishing to take their horse over to the rodeo after the Cowlitz County Fair has started and do not have a signed release form on file must petition the 4-H Horse Policy Committee ASAP. They must have a bona fide reason to take their horse out to another event and a legitimate reason that they missed the deadline date.
