Opportunity Grant Application Information Addition Funds

Application <u>must be received two weeks prior</u> (not postmarked by) to the event's due date.

Pierce County 4-H Youth Additional Funds Grants are offered by the 4-H Leaders Council to encourage our 4-H youth to participate in 4-H experiences, educational opportunities, and national competitions.

Eligibility: The youth must be submitting the Youth Opportunity Grant Application with this application.

Conditions: Only 1 Addition Funds Grant will be awarded to each 4-H member per year. The 4-H year is from October 1 to September 30. Recipients of a Pierce County 4-H Council Youth Opportunity Additional Funds Grant must be prepared to share their experiences with the Council upon returning. Contact the Council President to arrange a time.

Application Requirements:

- Applications must be complete.
- Amounts **must** align with those on Youth Opportunity Grant submitted.
- Submitted applications must be neat, legible, and completed by the applicant.
- Application can be filled in, signed, and sent electronically to Sadie.williams@wsu.edu.
- Completed applications are to be submitted to the 4-H County Extension Office two weeks prior to the
 due date for the upcoming event.

Selection Process:

Grants will be awarded based on the following:

- Completeness of application
- The reasons given for wanting to attend the event
- The explanation of how you plan to better serve 4-H and the community after attending
- Presentation to the Pierce County 4-H Leaders Council

All applications will be reviewed by the Leaders Council Scholarship Committee before being submitted to the Pierce County 4-H Council Leaders Council for final approval.

Distribution of Grant Funds:

The Pierce County 4-H Council will provide approved funds **directly to the organization** receiving registration of event, program, or opportunity. Please provide that contact information.

If funds cannot be paid directly to the organization, receipts must be submitted before reimbursement will be made to you.
