Pierce County 4-H Adult Grants are offered by the 4-H Council to encourage our 4-H leaders to participate in continuing education. Grants are awarded based on both the financial need and the willingness to work with the Pierce County 4-H Council.

Eligibility: Current 4-H Leader in good standing.

Conditions: As a recipient of a Pierce County 4-H Council Education Grant you must be willing to share what you have learned and its application thereof.

Application Requirements:

- Applications must be complete
- If traveling, submit a proposed budget (airfare, hotel, etc.)
- Submitted applications must be neat, legible, and completed by the applicant
- All required signatures/initials must be on the application
- Completed applications are to be submitted to the 4-H County Extension Office on or before the due date set by the 4-H Council for the upcoming event.

Selection Process:

Grants will be awarded based on the following:

- The statement of financial need
- Completeness of application
- Current involvement in 4-H
- The explanation on how this educational experience will help you as a volunteer 4-H Leader
- Willingness to share knowledge and time with Pierce County 4-H.

All applications will be reviewed by the Pierce County 4-H Council Scholarship Committee before being submitted to the 4-H Leaders Council for final approval.

Distribution of Grant Funds:

The Pierce County 4-H Council will provide approved funds directly to the organization receiving registration of event, program, or opportunity. If funds cannot be paid directly to organization, receipts must be submitted before reimbursement will be made to you.
