- 1. All applications will be reviewed for completeness immediately following the scholarship deadline. **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**
- 2. Verification will be made by the 4-H Agent and/or the 4-H Program Assistant that the applicant is a 4-H member in good standing and has met all minimum criteria.
- 3. All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Selection Committee. Applications will be rated and ranked based on the listed criteria (see insert).
- 4. Maximum score of 80 points can be awarded based on submitted materials.

- 5. The top five applicants receiving 50 points or more on the submitted materials will participate in an interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee.
- 6. Recipients of scholarships will be determined by the highest scores resulting from the above process.
- 7. Recipients of the scholarships will be declared at the Pierce County Fair in August.

### **DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS**

Each recipient of the Pierce County 4-H Council Scholarship will be given a check payable to the institute of higher learning upon proof of enrollment at said institution. Unclaimed scholarship funds after January 1 of the following year will revert to the 4-H Council.

The 4-H Council Executive Board reserves the right to suspend the awarding of the scholarship in any given year if no applicant meets the stated criteria or if, in the opinion of the Board, awarding the scholarship would not be in the best interests of the Pierce County 4-H Council or Washington State 4-H.
