

NOAA Fisheries – National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS)

NMFS is willing to provide technical assistance in the form of recommendations on how to minimize impacts on ESA-listed species and critical habitat directly to municipalities during emergency response efforts when there is no Federal involvement. In cases where there is Federal involvement, we recommend emergency section 7 consultation.

During any emergency situation, the primary objective of NMFS is to provide recommendations for minimizing adverse effects to ESA-listed species and critical habitat without impeding response efforts. During emergency events, protecting human safety and property should come first every time. Consequently, no constraints for protection of ESA-listed species or their critical habitat will be recommended if they place human lives or property in danger.

As you pass this on to municipalities or other interested parties, please ask that when seeking recommendations, they contact the respective branch chief for the geography where the emergency response will take place (map - branch contacts can also be found at:

EMERGENCY CONSULTATION

Section 7 regulations recognize that an emergency (natural disaster or other calamity) may require expedited consultation (50 CFR §402.05).

Where emergency actions are required that may affect listed species and/or critical habitats, a Federal agency may not have the time for the administrative work required by the consultation regulations under non-emergency conditions. Emergency consultations should be handled with as much understanding of the action agency's critical mission as possible while ensuring that anticipated actions will not violate sections 7(a)(2) or 7(d).

An emergency is a situation involving an act of God, disasters, casualties, national defense or security emergencies, etc., and includes response activities that must be taken to prevent imminent loss of human life or property.

Initial Contact by the Action Agency

The initial stages of emergency consultations usually are done by telephone or facsimile, followed as soon as possible (within 48 hours if possible) by written correspondence from the Services. This provides the Services with an accurate record of the telephone contact. This record also provides the requesting agency with a formal document reminding them of the commitments made during the initial step in emergency consultation.

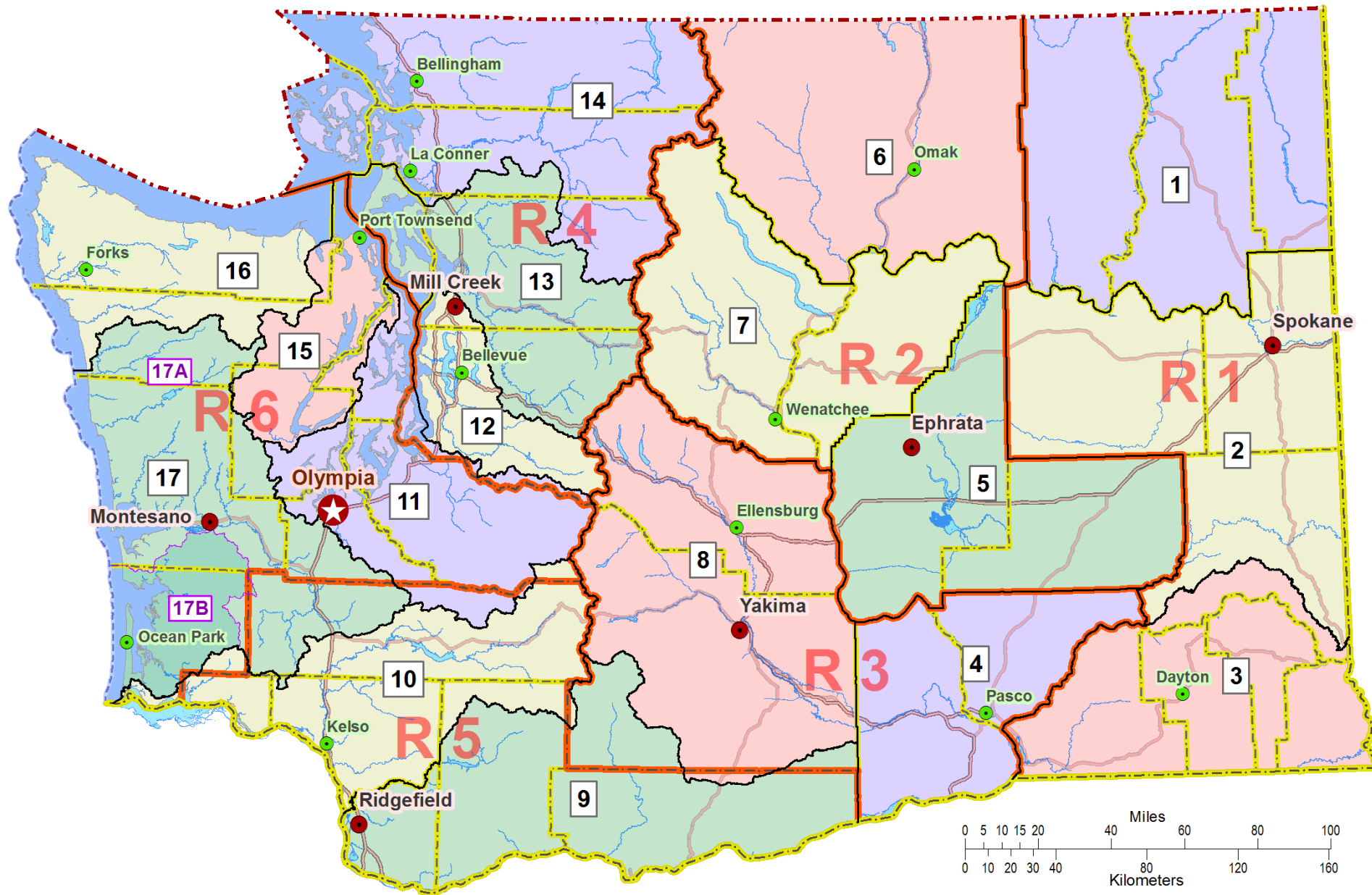
