



Budget

"Why do I have to pay for parking?"

WSU Transportation Services is a self-supported auxiliary and does not receive federal, state, grant or tuition funding. Revenue for capital projects, maintenance, and operations comes solely from parking fees and fines.





Transportation Unit Costs

Construction cost per garage space	30K/\$85K
