- Reviewed major search indexes for relevancy - consulted subject librarian
- Searched for literature since 2000
  - Except for first search term “Cooperative Extension” AND “Urban” OR “Metro” & “University Extension” AND “Urban” OR “Metro” ProQuest, ERIC – primarily because of JOE
- Imported into EndNote reference management software
- Noted the total number found, but removed duplicate references from database
- Entered organizational search terms to categorize references and assist in search use

- **Search Indexes used search order:**
  - ProQuest – particular attention to ERIC and dissertations
  - OCLC/First Search – particular attention to ERIC and WorldCat
  - EBSCO Host – particular attention to AGRICOLA and Urban Abstracts
  - Web of Science – particular attention to CAB Abstracts and Social Science Citation Index
  - Google Scholar

- Used Boolean Logic
- In search order:
  - “Cooperative Extension” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
    - Except Google - Looked for literature prior to 2000
  - “University Extension” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
    - ProQuest - Looked for literature prior to 2000
  - “Cooperative Extension” AND “City” OR “Cities”
  - “Urban Universities” AND “Community”
  - “University Outreach” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
  - “University Partnerships” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
  - “University Centers” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
  - “University Engagement” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
  - “Nonprofit” AND “University” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
  - “Applied Research” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”

- No assessment has been made on the quality or usefulness of the references located. . . future opportunity. . .
- Search term that located the most references
  - “Cooperative Extension” AND “Urban” OR “Metro”
  - Except in Google Scholar, where several of the search terms found similarly large numbers of references
- As might be expected, the different search terms found varying numbers of references

- After first round of searches, the search index that consistently produced the most results
  - Google Scholar
    - Found vary broad set of references
    - Wonder about the quality/usefulness
- Search index that consistently found the least
  - Web of Science

- **General CES**
  - Historical materials related to urban/metro
  - General information about urban/metro
  - University Extension, outreach, partnerships, community centers
  - Information about Extension and non-profits
  - General applied research, not related to any program
  - Any references that are not specifically program focused
- **Agriculture, Food Systems**
  - Urban ag, gardens, Master Gardeners and food systems



- **Community and Economic Development**
  - Community development, economic development, land use and housing
- **Health, Nutrition and Families**
  - SNAP, EFNEP, nutrition, health and wellness
  - Family financial literacy
  - Childcare and seniors
- **4-H, Youth Development**
  - 4-H, youth, anything about children
- **Natural Resources**
  - Water quality and SeaGrant
  - Urban forestry, insects and pests

- Free online access to EndNote is available through most university libraries, through the Web of Science search index

- Questions to ask of the literature (WMCER Fellows)
  - What does this piece suggest about key effective practices/strategies for ...?
  - What does this piece suggest about key capabilities (e.g. staffing, staff capacities, resources, etc.) for ....?
  - Were there any distinguishing factors that made this metropolitan?
- Availability of Database
  - Updating
