

Desired outcomes for successful reentry and reducing recidivism:

- a) Individuals are held accountable, supported and welcomed back into the community
- b) Individuals have improved access to programs and resources
- c) Increased partnerships and collaboration among entities and organizations as individuals move from incarceration to community
- d) Early and continuous access to reentry services including planning, coaching, mentoring, treatment, vocational training, and support ...
- e) Meaningful, wraparound community supervision and reentry services based on an individual's risk, need, and responsibility and informed by research and best practices
- f) Enforcement that creates accountability, enhances community safety, and aligns with best practices and research
- g) Addresses past/present disparities and promotes equitable outcomes for all communities
- h) Encourages successful reintegration into the community
- i) Reduced barriers to stability, independence, and participation in family and community.
- j) Ensures adequate resources for programs and services, including restorative justice
