# Pre-License Pesticide Applicator Review Course

Pre-license pesticide applicator review is for pesticide applicators, consultants, and dealers who would like to obtain a license or category.

## WSU Course Information

**This Pre-License applicator review is conducted in English** and focuses on eight of the 25 WSDA exams. Not all exam topics are covered in the course. Courses do not cover aquatics, public health, seed treatment, soil fumigation, or Pest Control Operator (PCO). All exam categories will be available on testing day. Testing is administered by Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA). All license types need to attend BOTH days of the course, except Dealer Managers who should attend Day 1 only. If you hold a valid pesticide license and are interested in adding a category, you need only attend the day that the category-specific information is covered (recertification credits are available).
