
Pursuant to RCW 28B.10.528, and the authority conferred on me by the WSU Board of Regents, I delegate to you the authority to administer and execute the following contracts on behalf of Washington State University that are related to your duties as the Vice Dean for Academic and Community Partnerships for the Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine, provided that all University policies and procedures and applicable laws in effect at the time of signature have been followed, and that you have completed all training required by the Contracts Office, Purchasing Services, and the Washington Department of Enterprise Services:

Template student clinical training affiliation agreements and template student clinical training implementation letters for the Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine which have been approved by the Office of Finance and Administration and the Office of the Attorney General. Any changes to template agreements must be approved by the Office of Finance and Administration prior to implementation.

This delegation of authority includes the obligation to manage and administer the contracts in accordance with the terms therein and to seek guidance on any particularly sensitive or difficult cases as appropriate, depending on the circumstances. This delegation of authority is effective immediately and will remain in effect as long as you hold the responsibilities associated with the position of Vice Dean for Academic and Community Partnerships for the Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine, or until revoked by me. By exercising this authority you acknowledge that you have completed the required training and understand the scope and limitations of your

delegation. I know you will use sound judgment in the execution of these responsibilities.
