Q & A

Q: How long does testing take?

A: The amount of testing hours will vary depending on the type of assessment requested. We recommend testing at least 3 hours at a time so that testing will be limited to 1-3 weeks. *Please allow time for wait list or scheduling issues.*

Q: How long until I receive my written report/results?

A: Following the last testing session, it will take 2-3 weeks for your written report to be completed. A feedback session will be scheduled to review the results.

Q: Where can I find you?

A: The Psychology Clinic is located in the northeast corner of Johnson Tower on WSU's Pullman campus. The clinic will provide parking in the Smith Center for Undergraduate Education (CUE) parking garage, for the length of your appointment only. The garage is located off of Stadium Way.
