

## Superheroes


It is common for children to struggle to persist through difficult tasks. A recent study, however, gives insight into what might help a child persist. Researchers found the concept of "self-distancing," which occurs when a child takes on the persona of a person outside themselves, can foster better perseverance. When children dressed up as a character like Batman or Rapunzel, they persevered on a tasks longer than those who did not dress as these characters.
