## Wh - Questions

Use of *Wh*-questions can increase discussion about STEM-related topics between parents and children. In a museum exhibit, some parents were instructed to build a structure while asking their child *Wh*-questions, such as *Who*, *What*, *Where*, *Why*, and *How*. Results showed parents who asked *Wh*-questions had more STEM-related conversations with their children in later building tasks.
