

## Wh-Questions

Use of Wh-questions can increase discussion about STEM-related topics between parents and children. In a museum exhibit, some parents were instructed to build a structure while asking their child Wh-questions, such as Who, What, Where, Why, and How. Results showed parents who asked Wh-questions had more STEM-related conversations with their children in later building tasks.
