Changes to Bidding Requirements:

1-1. SECTION 00 11 13 – Advertisement for Bids

Item 1. To better accommodate potential lead times for the pump. The contract time will become duration based instead of end date driven. Replace "Project Scope: Construct 2.5 million gallon irrigation storage pond at orchard site with secondary pump system intended to be used as the main irrigation supply. Substantial Completion shall be achieved by June 1, 2023. Bid shall be based on this Contract Time."

 - Response: Correct no work at the River nor west of the Highway at this time. That work will be a separate scope bid at a later date.
- 2. Section 02-22-00 1.3 B 2 describes the excavation work. At what point do we define getting into "rock" excavation? Specifically around the pump intake?
 - Response: Heavy rock is not expected to be encountered during excavation, likely to experience watermelon type river rock.
- 3. Do we know if the pump manufacturer is capable of meeting that schedule?
 - o Response: Contract time is being adjusted to accommodate lead times of critical components
- 4. Confirm that the Pre-Bid meeting was mandatory.
