



## Emergency Contact Numbers for Practicum

### EMERGENCY RESPONSE

What constitutes an emergency?

1. Personal injury, needle stick, fall
2. Medication or treatment errors
3. Unacceptable behavior

### RAPID CONTACT OF FACULTY (Within 24 hours)

1. Irresolvable conflict
2. Grave concerns related to ability
3. Projected mentor extended absences

*Monday through Friday, during the hours of 0700-1900 (12-hour day shift) call your faculty facilitator first for any Emergencies. If unable to reach your own faculty, then call the "On-Call" person. During all other hours, call the "On-Call Person" listed in the schedule below.*

It is fine to float to another unit with your preceptor or a preceptor you are assigned to work with. You do NOT need to get permission from your Faculty Facilitator or on-call person to float.
