MINUTES Board of Regents June 5, 2015

The Board of Regents of Washington State University (WSU) met pursuant to call in Open Meeting at a special meeting at 7:30 a.m., Friday, June 5, 2015, at the WSU Tri-Cities Campus, East Building, Room 212, Richland, Washington.
