## 3 Rivers Community Foundation

Specific to groups or students in Benton and Franklin counties.

## BECU

BECU Foundation Scholarships.

## Blue Mountain Community Foundation

Primarily in Walla Walla, Columbia, Garfield, or Umatilla counties.

## Chuckanut Health Foundation

For Whatcom County, some scholarships are specific to public health and health professions.

## The CIRI Foundation

Variety of education funding opportunities for Alaska Natives.

## Community Foundation for Southwest Washington

Variety of scholarships for high school seniors and current college students from southwest Washington counties.

## Community Foundation of North Central Washington

Variety of scholarships for high school seniors and current college students from north central Washington counties.

## Community Foundation of South Puget Sound

Variety of scholarships for high school seniors and current college students from south Puget Sound counties.

## Grays Harbor Community Foundation

Scholarships to local students (Grays Harbor County resident or graduate of Grays Harbor County High School) for education after high school, with emphasis on undergraduate education at any 2 or 4-year college or university.

## Hawai'i Community Foundation

State residents to attend an accredited 2 or 4-yr not-for-profit institution with the U.S.

## Homer Foundation

Graduating seniors from Homer High School or those on the Southern Kenai Peninsula.

### Kent Community Foundation

Variety of scholarships for Kent area high school seniors.

### The Oregon Community Foundation

Variety of scholarships for Oregon residents graduating from specific schools or areas.

### Pride Foundation

60+ scholarships for applicants who identify as LGBTQ+ and live in Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, or Washington.

### Renton Regional Community Foundation

A variety of scholarship funds for Washington Residents especially from Renton and Burien area high schools.

### San Juan Island Community Foundation

Four different scholarships to eligible high school graduates for higher education and career training.

### Seattle Foundation

A variety of scholarship funds for Washington Residents.

### Skagit Community Foundation

A variety of scholarship funds for students from Skagit County especially Mount Vernon High School.

### Whatcom Community Foundation

Administers the Whatcom Dollars for Scholars program for graduating high schools seniors in Whatcom County.

### Wyoming Community Foundation

A variety of scholarship funds for Wyoming residents / graduates; several are open to non-WY based institutions.
