

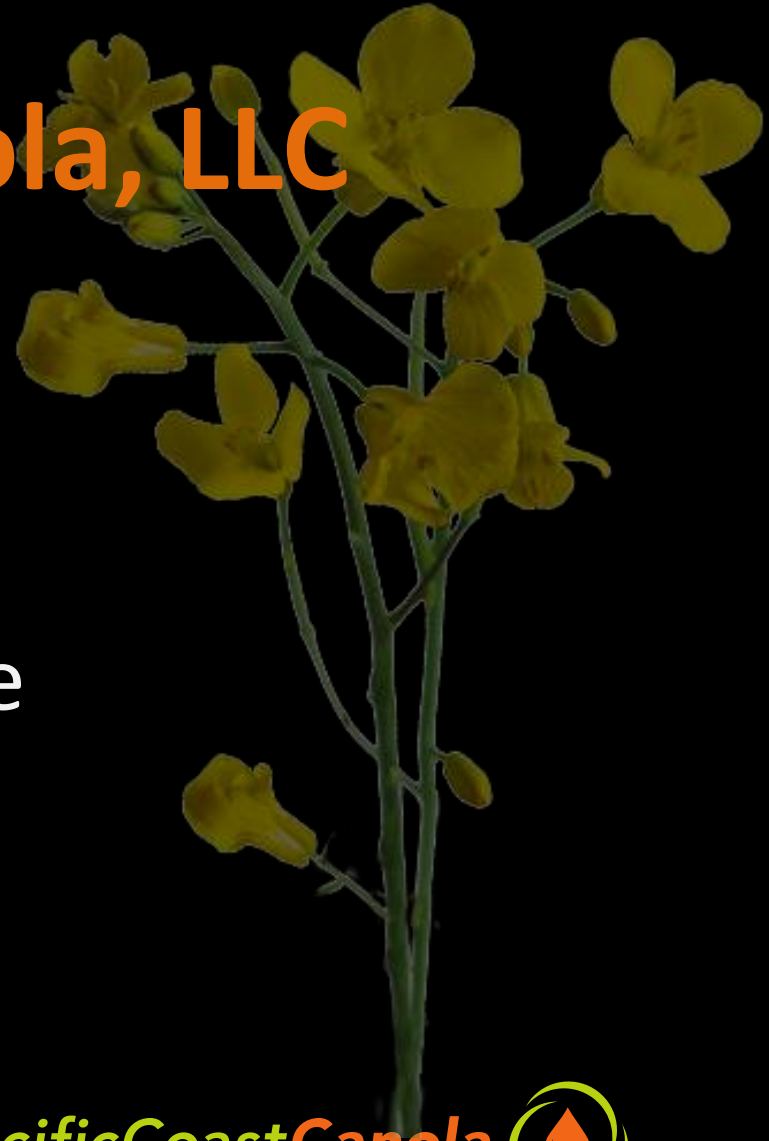

- We produce food-grade canola oil and canola meal

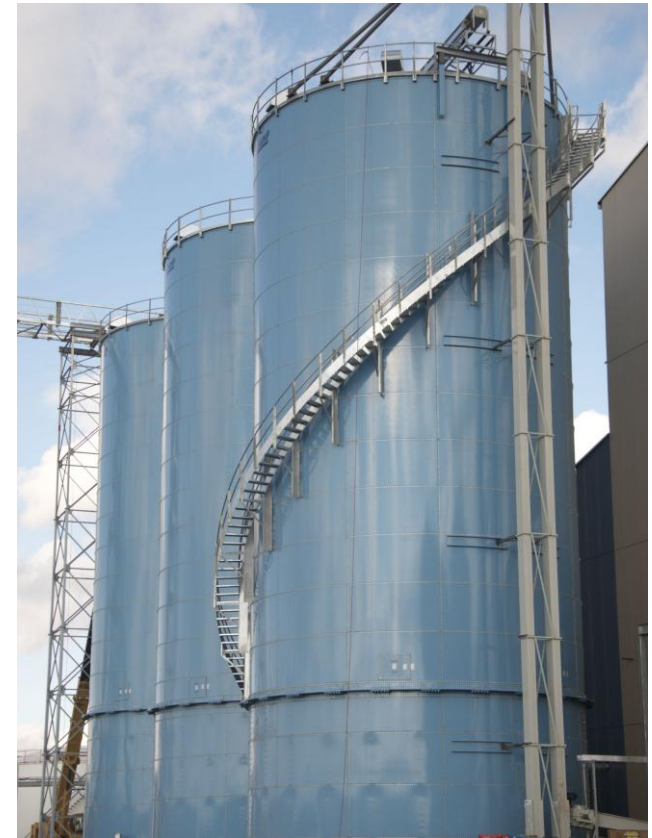

# About Pacific Coast Canola

- We buy 350,000 MT of canola seed per year
- We will spend roughly one billion dollars purchasing canola in the next 5 years
- Our goal is to originate all of our seed in the west
- We purchase winter and spring canola
- We also contract special varieties including High-oleic and Non-GMO



# Grow Canola

- PCC is the largest buyer of commodity canola in the PNW
- We have contracts available for Non-GMO spring canola
- We pay a premium for U of I winter variety (Non-GMO)

- Recent basis increase due to PCC demand
- PCC current bids higher than Canadian processors
