Phenomenally prolific in his scholarly activities focused on the health and safety of marginalized and precarious workers, Andrea Bazzoli excels in teaching and mentorship as well.

In his four years of studying organizational psychology at WSU, Andrea published 20 peer-reviewed papers, half of them as first author, and he has seven more manuscripts pending, along with three book chapters. He also delivered more than 30 presentations at national and international conferences and has already established an international, interdisciplinary research program.

As a classroom and laboratory instructor, Andrea created a welcoming, safe, and inclusive climate for students from all backgrounds. The WSU Graduate School awarded him an Excellence in Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion award in 2022.

He has also mentored six undergraduate researchers, and freely shares his talents and expertise with fellow graduate students.

Andrea is active on many significant University and professional committees and has garnered numerous awards for his outstanding scholarship and service. After graduation this spring, a full year earlier than usual, he will begin an assistant professor position at an R-1 research university in New York.
