Rationale Statement (MA Evolutionary Anthropology - Thesis)

The proposed changes to the requirements for the MA in Evolutionary Anthropology (see above) are designed to provide our graduate students greater flexibility in crafting a plan of study that is uniquely tailored to the demands of their thesis research without affecting the overall rigor of the program. To that end, we seek to reduce the minimum number of credits we require under the “Topics” category by 3, from 9 credits to 6 credits, while increasing the minimum number of credits we require under the “Electives” category by 3, from 6 credits to 9 credits. This change “frees up” 3 credits for students to use as they see fit—by taking an additional class in a different department to foster interdisciplinary research, by taking a non-graded (S/F) independent study in anthropology to deepen their understanding of a particular method or topic, or even by choosing to enroll in another graded evolutionary anthropology seminar as they would have in the absence of this change. In sum, expanding the minimum number of “Electives” credits will provide MA students greater freedom in choosing the combination of classes that best suits their research needs. These changes do not affect our minimum required number of credits, which remains at 32.

We wish to add Anth 569, Evolutionary Cultural Anthropology (currently taught by Prof. Barry Hewlett), to the list of courses students may take to fulfill the “Theory” requirement. While revising our graduate student handbook we realized that although Anth 569 is listed under the “Topics” requirement it is missing from the list of classes that satisfy the “Theory” requirement. We seek to correct that by adding Anth 569 to the list of classes that satisfy the “Theory” requirement for our MA students. This change ought to slightly increase enrollment numbers in future sections of Anth 569.
